Council Should Consider

Adopt Resolution 2018-016 Entering into a Limited Use Permit with MnDOT for the County Road F trail within the I-694 right-of-way.

Background/Discussion

Ramsey County is completing plans for their improvement to County Road F from Hamline Avenue (TH 51) to Lexington. Along with the improvements to the roadway, the trail on the south side of County Road F will be extended (Attachment A).

This trail extension will be built within the Hamline Avenue right-of-way. Since the City will be responsible for maintaining the trail per the Cooperative Agreement approved by Council on February 12, 2018, the City will be applying for a Limited Use Permit for the construction of this portion of the new trail within MnDOT right-of-way. The permit submittal requires a resolution from the City stating they will operate and maintain the facility within the MnDOT right-of-way.

Attached is Resolution 2018-016 which is in the format suggested by MnDOT. Staff would recommend adoption of Resolution 2018-016.
