Council Should Consider

Resolution 2018-017 approving a premise permit for Spring Lake Park Lions to conduct charitable gambling at Welsch’s Big Ten Tavern (Big Ten) for two years (expiring June 30, 2020).

Background/Discussion

The Council previously approved a charitable gambling license for the Roseville Area Hockey Association for charitable gambling at Big Ten. The Roseville Area Hockey Association has since terminated its lease with Big Ten and the business sought another opportunity with the Spring Lake Park Lions (applicant).

The applicant has been made aware of the requirements which include providing financial reports to the City. The necessary fee has been paid, all paperwork has been provided (see attachments) and a satisfactory background check has been conducted by the Ramsey County Sheriff’s Department.
