Council Should Consider

The Council should consider approving the formation of a Civic Site Advisory Committee.

Background

The TCAAP development has a 1.6 acre space zoned for Civic and Community use. Due to a previously agreed upon timeframe, the City is able to obtain the land, associated infrastructure and parking for one dollar within two years of the Master Developer Agreement (MDA) being signed. After the two years the City’s cost increases and expires at seven years. The City Council has given direction to form a Civic Site Task Force (Advisory Committee) comprised of current committee and commission members and other key individuals. The City Council held a Special Work Session on May 22nd, 2018, which the Council gave direction on key elements of the task force. The attached resolution will establish the advisory committee, and set the general direction.
