MNDOT ACCESS STUDY - PRELIMINARY DISCUSSION

SNELLING AVENUE (HIGHWAY 51) AT HAMLINE AVENUE

A representative from the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) will discuss plans to study access along Snelling Avenue (Highway 51), including the center median access that is temporarily closed at Hamline Avenue, during the upcoming Arden Hills City Council Work Session meeting on November 18th. Vehicles traveling southbound on Snelling Avenue could previously make a left turn onto southbound Hamline Avenue prior to the center median closure. MnDOT anticipates this closure to remain through the duration of the I-35W project.

During the work session, a MnDOT representative will describe the future study process to determine if the temporary access closure on Highway 51 at Hamline Avenue should become a permanent closure or be restored following completion of the I-35W project. MnDOT will also describe the public engagement process that will occur during the MnDOT study to allow for resident participation and input.

Residents are welcome to attend the work session, but an opportunity for public testimony and questions are generally not permitted during this preliminary discussion between MnDOT and the City Council. A summary of the study process and schedule will be provided on the Arden Hills website following the work session.
