- Resolution 2022-030 entering into a Master Partnership Contract with Minnesota Department of Transportation.

Background/Discussion

Attached is a copy of a proposed Master Partnership Contract (MPC) between the Minnesota Department of Transportation (Mn/DOT) and the City of Arden Hills. The current MPC will expire on June 30th, 2022.

The Master Partnership Contract provides a framework for Mn/DOT and Local Agencies to provide services and payment to each other. It also authorizes the Commissioner of Transportation to make arrangements with and cooperate with any governmental authority for the purposes of constructing, maintaining and improving the trunk highway system. A few MnDOT provided routine services are included in the contract (see Exhibit A within Attachment A) but all other services require work orders describing costs and scope. This contract will be effective on July 1st, 2022 and will expire June 30th, 2027.
