Council Should Consider

Motions to approve, table or deny the following:

- Resolution 2022-035 Approving Charitable Gambling License Renewals for Chops, Inc. at Flaherty’s Arden Bowl; Spring Lake Park Lions at Welsch’s Big 10 Tavern; and Minnesota Fastpitch Academy at Northern Lights Bingo.

All items need a simple majority for action unless otherwise noted.

Background

Chops, Inc., Spring Lake Park Lions, and Minnesota Fastpitch Academy have submitted an application and all necessary supporting documents in order to renew their charitable gambling license with the City at the above-referenced locations (current licenses expire on June 30, 2022). Licenses are valid for two years.

According to the terms of the application, 10% of the net profits are to be contributed to the City of Arden Hills to a special fund administered by the City Council; and they will also pay a Local Gambling Tax of 3% of their gross receipts (less prizes paid out) to the City to cover expenses incurred for regulating gambling activity.

These organizations have been regularly submitting their loss/profit information to the City without issue for their current licenses and staff recommends the Council consider approving the license renewals.
