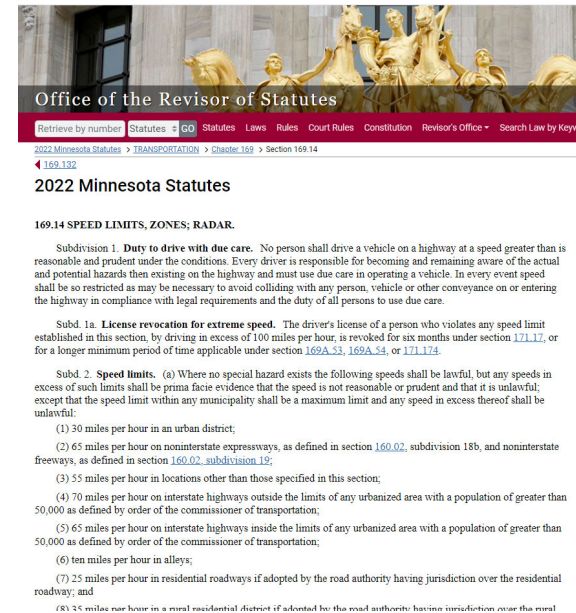

➤ New Local Road Speed Limit Process

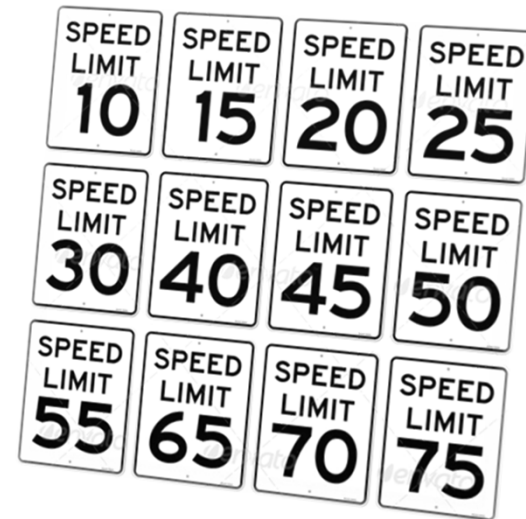
- **August 2019**
- Minn. Statute 169.14 Subd. 5h – **Speed limits on City Streets**
- **Cities can lower speed limits on streets under City jurisdiction**
- **As a minimum, analysis must consider:**
 - national urban speed limit guidance & studies
 - effective communications on the change
 - local crashes
- **Education and Enforcement**

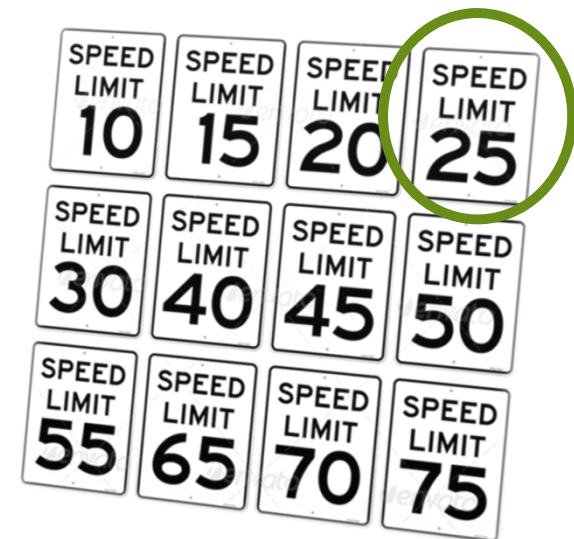
