**Discussion**

The City of Arden Hills is a member of the Twin Cities Gateway Visitors Bureau, being a member the City is entitled to at least one spot on the Board of Directors. That spot is reserved for a member of the City Council, and is currently Mayor Grant. Based on annual hotel tax revenues, cities may be eligible for another spot on the board; Arden Hills became eligible for another spot based on 2022 revenues. This additional spot must be from one of the hotels in their respective City, in Arden Hills that's either the Quality Inn or Springhill Suites. Al Stauffacher, the Director of the Gateway Visitors Bureau, reached out to the hotels to gauge interest and recruit a member on behalf of Arden Hills. His recommendation is Shua Vang from Springhill Suites.
