



Neighbor Consent for Keeping of Chickens

Instructions: Talk to neighbors immediately adjacent to your property lines (property lines border one another) and tell them you intend to keep up to 3 chickens. Provide the neighbor the consent form and request they return to city hall.

- You must obtain 100% consent from the adjacent properties.
- Failure of a neighboring Property Owner to respond does not constitute consent.
- If you believe an adjacent property is vacant, contact the Community Development Department at (651) 792-7800.
- Consent forms shall be provided to the adjacent Property Owners by you as the potential licensee in order to provide an explanation to their neighbor of plans for the keeping of chickens in accordance with city ordinances. Providing a copy of the site plan submitted with the license application is strongly encouraged.
- Adjacent neighbors are not asked to provide consent immediately to the potential licensee. **Adjacent neighbors are asked to return the form directly to city offices in a timely manner.**

The license process requires potential licensees to obtain neighbor consent from those properties immediately adjacent to their residence.
